### REGULATIONS:

**ENTRIES:** Entry on the day, close at start. Helmets must be worn. Entries must be made on the official Entry Form and include the entry fee of £10.00 (members)/£15.00 (non-members). Cheques should be made payable to **Hawks Cheltenham Spa MCC**. Results will be available on the web site, **if results are required by post please supply a stamped SAE when signing on!**

**MACHINE ELIGIBILITY:** The machines eligible for the event must conform to the current rules. In general all machines must utilise engine, frame, forks, gearbox and hubs manufactured of the period and be fitted with an efficient silencer.

**COURSE:** The course will be laid out at Upper Colgate Farm, Ham Road, Whittington, Cheltenham, Glos. GL54 4EZ, entirely on private land and will comprise 10 sections to be completed over 4 laps. All sections will be laid out in the style of a trial in the 1960's.
